As of Tuesday, at least 50 police cruisers, two paddy wagons, and several vans carrying “equipment” have gathered near Caledonia, Ontario. Now is the time to show support by holding solidarity actions, calling officials, or doing whatever you can. Get the colonizers to call off their dogs!

**Women Warriors in Grassy Narrows Fasting Against Colonization**

This Thursday through Sunday, women in Grassy Narrows will be fasting at the Slant Lake blockade site against attacks on the earth, to support each other as women, and to send

**Free Sam Kuhn of the Belleville Tenant Action Group**

Since 2000, the Tenant Action Group (TAG) in Belleville has been responsible for preventing nearly 1000 evictions, over 1263 Hydro cutoffs, defending welfare cases, and was part of a slew of squatting actions to combat homelessness. When the local MPP broke a promise to address rollbacks of the Special Diet Allowance, he found his office under attack by TAG members.
