More Blockading on Grassy Narrows Traditional Territory

On July 25th, plans were underway for Grassy Narrows blockaders and supporters to blockade logging trucks on English River Road. Look for updates soon at <http://friendsofgrassynarrows.com>, the website of a Winnipeg-based support group. Grassy Narrows is an Anishinabe community an hour north of Kenora which began a permanent logging blockade near Slant Lake four years ago to fight clear-cutting on their traditional territory, and who have been carrying out temporary roving blockades ever since. The community had previously tried for ten years to have their voice heard through the "official channels". They made headlines a week and a half ago when Grassy Narrows blockaders and their supporters blockaded logging trucks on the Trans-Canada highway for twelve hours, leading to a dozen arrests.

WTO Talks Collapse

Global free trade talks organized by the World Trade Organization, (WTO) called the "Doha round" of negotiations have been suspended indefinitely. A major bone of contention was rich countries' unwillingness to dismantle their huge subsidies and open up their markets. All along, the rich countries have wanted free trade for poor countries, but not for themselves. Large groups of people have protested the WTO's bolstering of the agenda of multinational corporations, notably in Seattle in 1999, and in Hong Kong in 2005.
