national day of remembrance & action on violence against women

On December 6th, the University of Winnipeg Womyn's Centre is planning two events to remember the Montreal massacre and all the victims and survivors of gendered violence, and to raise awareness of the realities of violence against womyn today.

At 11:45am Womyn's Centre members will be staging a die-in in at the Riddell Atrium and in front of the escalators at the U of W (515 Portage Ave.) At 12:30 a memorial service will be held in the quad (in front of the portage ave entrance).

Art has been placed at various locations around campus, including breast casts painted with statistics about violence against womyn that were installed November 20th. For more information on the days events, contact the Womyn's Centre at 786-9788.

History of the Montreal massacre: On December 6th, 1989 Marc

Lepine entered the Ecole Polytechnique in Montreal. He began his attack by entering a classroom at the university where he separated male and female students. After claiming that he was “fighting feminism”, he shot all 9 women in the room, killing 6. He then moved through corridors, the cafeteria and another classroom specifically looking for women to shoot. He killed 14 women and injured 4 men and 10 women before turning the gun on himself. Ever since, December 6th has been commemorated as the national day of remembrance and action on violence against women.
