Winnipeg Activists to protest School of the Americas
windymedia – November 16th is marked by SOA Watch as the international day to remember the victims of the students of the School of the Americas (SOA). The date was chosen in remembrance of the November 16th, 1989 massacre of 8 people at the university of Central America (UCA). Every year on this date, roughly 20,000 people gather both to remember and draw attention to the fact that despite the US government changing the name of the school in the face of the publics demand for the school's closure, the School of the America's still exists and the people are not fooled.

From November 15th-19th, Winnipeg activists will travel to Fort Benning, Georgia in what the Student Christian Movement (SCM)

terms a “pilgrimage of resistance”. The will be stopping en route to visit “communities of resistance and faith in the US, learn about issues of justice, oppression and nonviolence and form friendships and networks that will help transform our world. The SCM gather activists from all over Canada to points in Winnipeg and Toronto where caravans will form to travel to the School of the Americas for November 16th.
