Rioting erupts again in Paris suburbs

In Villiers-le-bel, France, with rocks raining down upon them, police lined the streets of the increasingly tense suburb Tuesday where angry youths have vowed to seek the revenge for the deaths of two teenagers who died in a collision with a police car.

The violence was triggered by the death of two teenagers on a motorbike who were killed in a crash with a police car on Sunday night. The scene, with angry youths targeting police mostly with firebombs, rocks and other projectiles, was reminiscent of the three weeks of rioting in 2005.

More than 80 officers were injured on Monday evening – four of them as a result of gunfire – and the rage was still simmering on

tuesday afternoon.

Six of the police officers injured in monday's clashes were in serious condition, according to Francis Debuire, a police union official. Four were injured by gunfire, including one who lost an eye and another who suffered a shattered shoulder. 25 officers were injured in total on Sunday night.
