Students facing expulsion after anti-war sit-in

Over 70 high school students at West Morton High School in Berwyn, Illinois took part in an anti-war sit-in on thursday, november 1st or All Saints Day in the U.S. Of the 70 students, 37 were given 10 days suspensions and expulsion papers from the superintendant Ben Nowakowski, who is standing firm on the punishment despite a rush of appeals from parents of the students involved. The protest began in the lunchroom, but moved outdoors on the promise from police, who were quick on

the scene, that no one would be arrested if it was taken outside.

The sit-in came only 2 weeks after a student had been arrested for bringing a semi-automatic hand gun to the very same school.
