Hollow Water Land Conflict

The Hollow Water First Nation, located 190 km northeast of Winnipeg has set up road blockades to all but permanent residents due to their frustration with a lack of consultation on proposed cottage developments in the area. Chief Ian Bushie has indicated that he extended an invitation to Conservation Minister Stan Struthers, who declined saying he would not schedule a meeting until the blockades were down.

Death toll in Iraq surpasses 1 million

A recent poll done by independent, non-partisan research group Just Foreign Policy has estimated the death toll in Iraq to be currently sitting at 1.05 million. The study was based on an extrapolation from a study published in the prestigious British journal, The Lancet, in October 2006 estimating that over 650,000 civilians had died as a result of the war.
