Anniversary of Haiti Coup

February 29th marks the third anniversary of the coup in Haiti that saw democratically elected Haitian President, Bertrand Aristide. Aristide was kidnapped and flown to the Central African Republic where he was held at a French military base. Over 500 members of the Canadian Forces were stationed around the Haitian capital of Port-au-Prince to help execute the coup, including the Joint Task Force 2, Canada's elite military unit, whose job it was to secure the airport at Port-au-Prince.

Following the coup, the United States appointed a de facto government, while the RCMP trained local Haitian police forces now blamed for numerous brutal acts of political repression against pro-democracy demonstrators. Many Lavalas (Aristide's party) supporters have been arrested and held as political prisoners for extended periods following the coup.
