Former Black Panther Denied Entry Into Canada

From the Ottawa Citizen -- The Canadian government is refusing Bobby Seale entry to Canada and denying students an opportunity to hear a legendary civil rights activist, according to a University of Ottawa group that invited the former Black Panther Party chairman to speak at an event this [past] weekend.... In a letter to Public Safety Minister Stockwell Day protesting the decision to deny Seale permission to come to Ottawa, [OPIRG board member Michael] Cheevers wrote that, "There are no valid reasons to prevent him from speaking in Canada now, considering he has been allowed to speak multiple times in this country since the 1960s, in particular to raise awareness in high schools about racism and related issues."
