Radio Universidad Reoccupied in Oaxaca in Preparation for May Day

indymedia.org -- On Monday at 5pm, students of Benito Juarez Autonomous University and sympathizers of the Popular Assembly of the People of Oaxaca (APPO) occupied Radio Universidad in preparation for the May Day general strike, in which the Section 22 Teachers' Union will march to the main square, the Zocalco, in Oaxaca City. Radio hosts are asking for support to reinforce the radio installations in case of state repression, and saying that the radio and university will be occupied for two days. Oaxaca is a province in southern Mexico which, this past year, saw a broad rebellion against the state government, which was initiated by a teachers' strike. Universities, radio stations, and other state institutions were occupied by popular organizations. In the fall of 2006, paramilitaries repeatedly lay siege to the radio station and attempted to evict its new owners. After a violent battle with the Federal Preventive Police on November 25th, nearly a month after the eviction attempts began, the station fell to the government. The reoccupation this week is the first time a radio station has been occupied in Oaxaca city since that time.

Sisters in Spirit March on May 13th

The Sisters in Spirit campaign seeks to raise public awareness of the alarmingly high rates of violence against indigenous women in Canada. Last week, another native woman was found murdered in Winnipeg. The Sisters in Spirit Mother's Day march will take place on May 13th at 1pm outside the St. Regis Hotel.
