### Grand Opening of the "The Rocker" this Friday

This week a fourth events row has been added to the Usurpa bulletin with the kickoff of the Rudolf Rocker Cultural centre, a new radical space in Winnipeg focussed on art and struggle. Come out to the grand opening this weekend for the opening of a multimedia retrospective exhibit of the 2001 resistance to the Quebec City Summit of the Americas, the Organization of American States (OAS)'s attempt to finalize the Free Trade Area of the Americas (FTAA).

On Tuesday, Roberta Keesick of Grassy Narrows first nation was served a summons to appear in court in Red Lake, Ontario after failing to comply with a March 2004 Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources "Stop Work" order on a cabin she has been building on her traditional hunting grounds.
