### War Resistance in Ontario

On May 9<sup>th</sup> in Ottawa, in the vicinity of the War Department, a group calling itself "The National Capital Crimes Commission" splashed in red the slogan "CANADA OUT OF KANDAHAR". In a communique, the NCCC, declared "this August, another 2000 Canadian troops will arrive in Afghanistan, to continue the work of bringing ruin and despair to that country. But this bloody war can be stopped, when enough of us take action to make it untenable for the government to continue." On May 10<sup>th</sup>, a group of anarchists in Guelph paint bombed the Canadian Forces Armory. That group's stament said "a week ago the police cars of the Guelph Police Department were paint-bombed, in solidarity with those people resisting police violence at home... We see no difference in the police being used on the streets of Guelph for social cleansing and the perpetuation of daily capitalism which kills and maims so many, to the Canadian military's role to police the world into the hegemony of free market capitalism, and dominant cultural homogeneity."

railway ties collective -- "Twice in one year, in April of 2006 and 2007, community members from the Bay of Quinte Mohawks shut down the rail lines passing through their territory of Tyendinaga. The first time was in response to the OPP attack on the Six Nations reclamation site near Caledonia, Ontario. The second time was in response to the provincial refusal to revoke the operating permit for a private non-native gravel quarry on land that the federal government acknowledges belongs to the Mokawks." There has been a national call for solidarity disruptions on June 29<sup>th</sup> of this year across "Canada".
