### War on Music: The Newest Winnipeg Worker Co-op

Next week, 333 Gary will open its doors as a worker co-operative record store specializing in punk/hardcore/metal/rock/stoner/sludge/crust/power/tech/grind/doom/speed/melodic/raunchy/old school/oi school/street/skate and more. They will be offering discounts on records to volunteers, provide letter-sized photocopies for 5¢, as they put it "cheaper than the corporate shitfucks at Portage Place," and do poster sized (11x17") copies. They'll also make custom t-shirts, hoodies, patches, buttons, stickers, and do in-house screenprinting. Union made shirts starting at \$7+screen with no minimums and the possibility of selling on consignment. Starting in July, they'll be hosting early evening punk shows. As if that weren't already enough, they will have four classic arcade games in the store at a time, rotating through Tetris, X-men, Bust-a-Move, WWF Superstars, Metal Slug, Pang, and more, for the retro price of 25¢ a pop. Doors open June first with a Grand Opening party toward the middle of the month.
