Atlantica's Push for "Business without Borders"

This week in Halifax, students, labour, peace groups, environmental organizations, and many more, are coming together to resist the Atlantic Northeast Eco-nomic Region (Ainer), known as Atlantica, pushing free trade throughout the Maritime Provinces, New England, southern Quebec, and the New England states. Just like the Hemispheria conference in Winnipeg last summer, and the WTO/FTAA/IMF/WB/ etc. before it, Atlantica is taking place behind closed doors, ignoring the needs of the bulk of the people in the area, to push the interests of neoliberal capitalism. Teach-ins, town hall meetings, pickets, picnics, and, yes, a critical mass bicycle ride are planned as part of the resistance. More information at <http://resist.stopatlantica.org>

US Prosecutors Seek to Add 20 Years to Sentences for "Eco-terrorists"

The Dominion -- Prosecutors in the US are seeking "terrorism enhancements" for the sentences of 10 animal rights and environmental activists arrested for causing more than \$40 million in damages to targets that included an SUV dealership, a meatpacking plant and a ski resort. "This is the first time in the history of the US that the federal government is seeking this enhancement for property crimes that did not result in injury or death to humans," said Lauren Regan of the Civil Liberties Defense Center in Eugene, Oregon. These enhancements could add up to 20 years to the existing jail sentence.
