### The Canada Haiti Action Network Presents: "Hands Off Haiti"

Hands Off Haiti is a compilation CD featuring Propagandhi, The Dope Poets, Mood Ruff, DL Incognito, Lal Forest, and Mohamad Ali. It's a project of the Canada Haiti Action Network, a national grassroots solidarity group determined to raise awareness about the real effects of the Government of Canada's support for the February 29, 2004 coup d'etat that overthrew Haiti's democratically elected government. All funds raised go directly to the Haitian-based grassroots organization "Sant Observasyon Sitwayen" (SOS), a citizen watchdog group whose motto is, "Politics is too important to be abandoned to the politicians." They may also go towards the Institute for Justice and Democracy in Haiti.
