Winnipeg Mourns the Loss of Dave Brophy

On the morning of Monday, June 9th, 2007, Dave Brophy took his own life after a long struggle with depression. The coming months will be difficult for all who knew him well, but we can take comfort in the exemplary life that Dave led. From his determined efforts to organize indigenous solidarity with the Friends of Grassy Narrows, to fill shifts at the Junto library, to organize discussions with the New Socialist Group, to speak out against environmental destruction, to his friendly and casual attitude in working with people, and his refreshing lack of judgmentalism or cliquishness...

Already, memorials in his memory have included:

- Dave's now white-painted bike, has been left locked outside the ArtSpace building, to recognize his days as a bicycle messenger, his devotion to cycling, and to remember the time spent working with him at the Bike Dump
- An apple tree was planted in his memory in the community garden on Young street between Ellice and Sargent
- A CD of Dave's favourite music was made and passed around at his memorial service
- A group of his writings are being collected to be distributed
- A bursary is being planned in his honour, memory, and spirit
