Mobilization Against the SPP: Protest Against Bush, Harper & Calderon

This August, Stephen Harper, George Bush and Felipe Calderon will be just 90 minutes from Montreal, in Montebello, Quebec (Between Ottawa and Montreal). Mobilize and Protest at the meeting of the Security and Prosperity Partnership (SPP), August 19-21, 2007. A main Day of Action against the SPP will take place on Monday, August 20 at 3pm at the Chateau Montebello (or as close as possible to Montebello). We encourage everyone to mobilize to Montebello by 3pm on August 20. Montebello, Quebec is a tourist village between Ottawa and Montreal, on Highway 148, on the Ottawa River.

Actions will also take place from August 19-21. An "anti-capitalist camp" will be set up in the area, as early as August 8, for all protesters who want to be in the region early to help plan actions and raise awareness. More details forthcoming. Earth First! Defeat NATO in the Netherlands

indymedia.org For two years *GroenFront!*—Dutch & Belgian *Earth First!*—have been fighting with the local community in Schinveld, in the southeast of the country, to preserve a forest that would be destroyed for the sake of the NATO airforce base across the German border. A direct action camp was evicted in January, and 15 acres were destroyed, but 35 acres saved. *GroenFront!* was preparing to reoccupy the woods awaiting the final outcome of a legal battle between the local council and national government, but now to great surprise, the protestors have been vindicated and the forests are definitely saved from NATO's bloody claws. On July 18th the Dutch highest administrative court ruled that the logging of Schinveld forest is illegal. This means the ministry of defence cannot continue the logging of the forest as requested by NATO, it also means the logging of the first six hectares in January 2006 was illegal. The forest would need to be destroyed to allow AWACS radar planes to lift off with more fuel in order to fly directly to Afghanistan and Iraq.
