U.S.-Canada Days of Action set for January 25-26

The War Resisters Support Campaign (Canada) has called for a Canada-wide mobilization on Saturday, January 26th to ensure that deportation proceedings against U.S. war resisters cease immediately, and that a provision be enacted by Parliament in order to allow resisters to stay. January 26th is the forth anniversary of US war resister Jeremy Hinzman applying for political refugee status in Canada. In the United States, supporters are encouraged to organize delegations of concerned community members to visit local Canadian Consulates across the country on Friday, January 25. Additionally, supporters are urged to hold vigils or other public events that day, or the following day Saturday, January

FBI Wiretaps Dropped Due to Unpaid Bills

WASHINGTON (AP) – A recent Justice Department audit reported that telephone companies have cut off FBI wiretaps used to eavesdrop on suspected criminals because of the bureau's repeated failures to pay phone bills on time.

In the audit, faulty bookkeeping was blamed for not paying the bills, as well as in the case of an FBI agent who pleaded guilty in June 2006 to stealing \$25,000 for her own use, the audit noted.
