Tyendinaga Declares Victory

The Dominion -- After a week of tension the police services have declared withdrawal from the Tyendinaga Mohawk Territory. Though announcing today all Ontario Provincial Police barricades are to be removed, cruisers and helicopters continue to survey the area. Satisfied with the outcome, the Mohawk defenders of the Quarry have declared victory, consequent to which all solidarity blockades at Six Nations in Caledonia have also been removed. Three members of the Tyendinaga Mohawks remain in custody though two were released on Monday, April 28th, 2008. Supplies, a trailer, a barbecue, food, and some vehicles belonging to the Mohawk community have been taken by the police forces and are still not returned. Meanwhile, non-Native allies have been assembling and delivering supplies from various Ontario cities to support the Mohawks in their struggle since Friday, April 25th, 2008. The community estimates police surveillance will continue until Thursday when the remaining detainees are scheduled to appear in court. For this purpose they are requesting monetary assistance with legal fees and will be holding various fundraisers.
