::: News ::: NATIVE YOUTH PROTEST 2010 OLYMPICS

Activists Kanahus Pelkey and Dustin Johnson have embarked on a three-week speaking tour across the East Coast and Great Lakes entitled "No Olympics on Stolen Land" to illuminate the threat. "By having the Olympics [outside Vancouver], it opens our land, our sacred sites, our medicine grounds," Pelkey said. "All these big corporations are going to see the potential in our land, and we want them to know that our land is not for sale," she added. The speaking tour comes after over a year of actions and protests aimed at shedding light on indigenous concerns with the Olympics. Last February, indigenous groups protested the three-year countdown celebration. In October, 1,500 indigenous people attended the Gathering of the Indigenous Peoples of America in Mexico to declare a public rejection of the Olympics. Native groups also plan to protest the two-year countdown celebration next month. "They'll never stop us. The spirit that our people have, and the knowledge that this is our land, is something that they cannot take away," Pelkey said. http://no2010.com/
