CALLOUT TO SUPPORT ALBERT DOUGLAS, political prisoner

For the past 4 months Albert Douglas has sat isolated within a cell after an arrest by racist pigs on [Highway] 401 on Sept. 27, 2007. The Kanadian government is accusing him of assault, attempted murder, robbery and unlawful confinement, among other charges. They have held

him against his will in an internment camp in Kanada, located at 165 Barton St. on occupied land called Hamilton. Albert has been criminalized for defending his land & his people. If you would like to show your support and solidarity for Albert, Albert appears before the court in Cayuga for a bail review on Thursday Feb. 28th @ 10:00 am. Support is strongly needed for for this date, please dress "nice" & act respectfully towards the courts. Albert also has scheduled dates for March 3rd @ 10AM to review charges. Albert's pre-trail date is on march 31st @ 10AM, this is not a public hearing but they will address the public directly after.
